



Synodon Closes \$1.2M Private Placement

For Immediate Release

Edmonton, Alberta – February 14, 2006 - Synodon Inc., a developer of advanced remote sensing technologies, announces that it has closed a non-brokered private placement for gross proceeds of \$1,200,000. The closing was comprised of 3,000,000 units at \$0.40 per unit. Each unit is comprised of one common share and one quarter common share purchase warrant, with one full purchase warrant being exercisable for one common share at a price of \$0.60 per share on or before December 31, 2006 and for a price of \$0.70 from January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007. The Placement was led by a group of Alberta and Colorado based private investors.

The proceeds will be used by Synodon to finalize the manufacturing of its realSens technology and initiate the commercialization effort.

Synodon Inc. (*synodon.com*) - a private Edmonton based technology company - is developing an advanced natural gas pipeline leak detection system called *realSens*[™] which is based on correlation spectroscopy technologies developed under the Canadian Space Program and by Synodon scientists.

Synodon's initial market is the world's 4.8 million kilometer natural gas pipeline network, stretching the equivalent of 120 times around the globe. Synodon's technology is able to detect small quantities of a wide variety of gases and can be applied in fields as diverse as search and rescue, mineral exploration and atmospheric pollution monitoring.
